<u>Starbucks Reserve Roastery:</u> Experience one of the largest Starbucks® stores in the world! If Willy Wonka had built the ultimate coffee shop instead of a chocolate factory, the result may have looked a lot like the 15,000-square-foot Starbucks Reserve Roastery. Located only a few blocks from the Hyatt Regency!

<u>Pike Place Market:</u> Explore Seattle's public market and one of the country's oldest farmers markets, established in 1907. Encompassing nine acres, the Market contains a historic arcade, winding alleys, stairways and lower levels offer a multisensory experience of sights, sounds, tastes, aromas and textures.

<u>Amazon Spheres</u>: The Spheres are a result of innovative thinking about the character of a workplace and an extended conversation about what is typically missing from urban offices— a direct link to nature. The Spheres are home to more than 40,000 plants from the cloud forest regions of over 30 countries. Open to the public only during the first and third Saturday of each month. Reservations online are available 30 days in advance.

Olympic Sculpture Park: Explore Seattle's largest green space, home to outdoor sculptures, native gardens, and plenty of room to spread out and relax with views of the Olympic Mountains and Puget Sound.
